

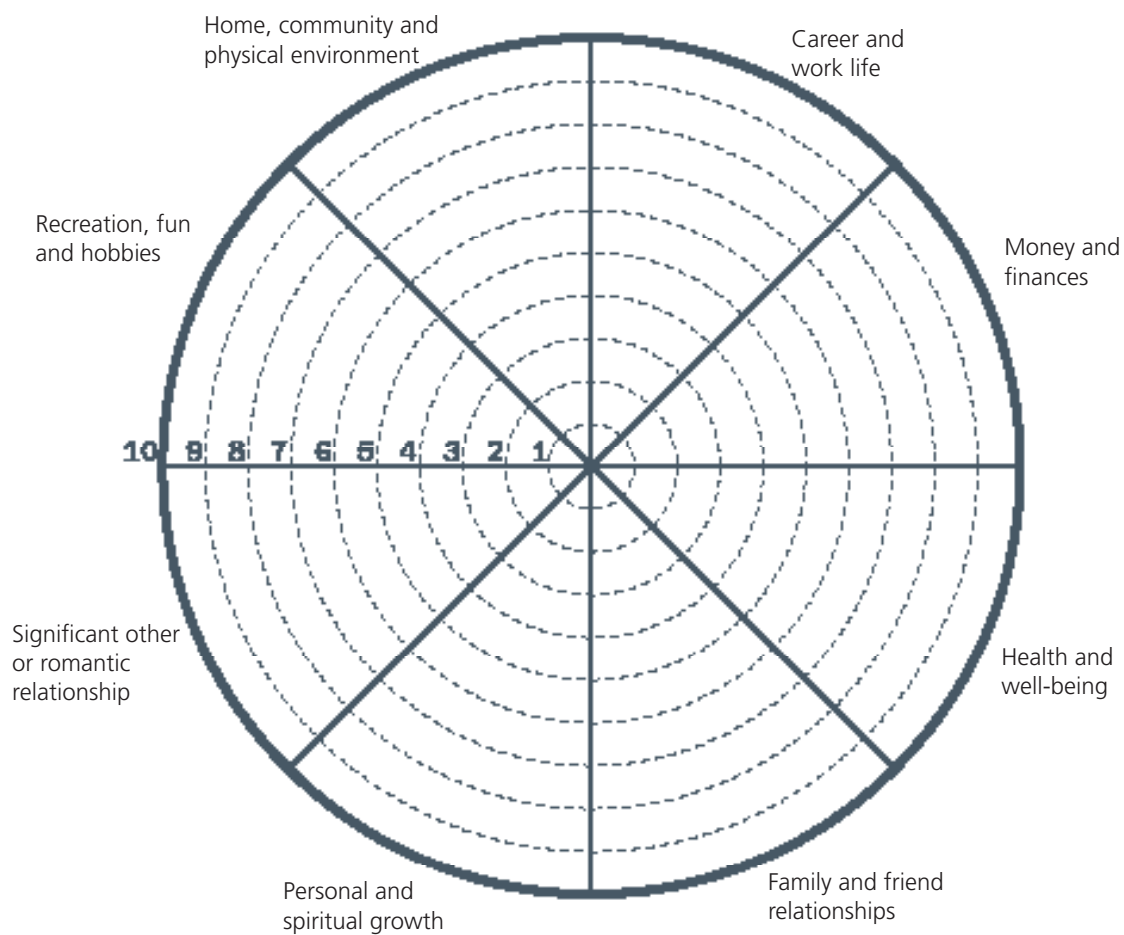
Assessing satisfaction

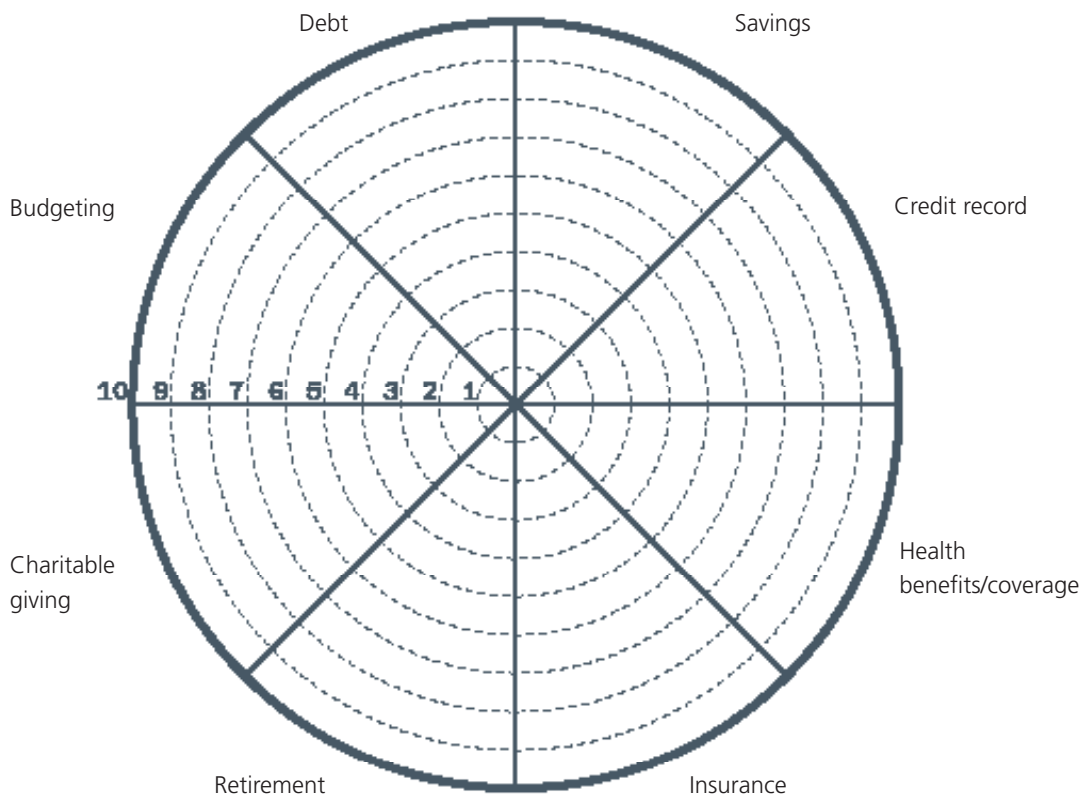
