Lima bean experiment

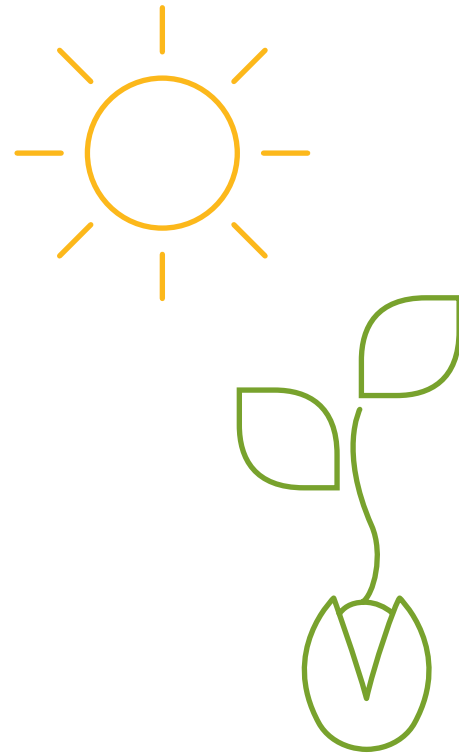
Watch a little bean grow and transform into a plant in just a few days in your own window!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Dry bean seeds.
- Paper towel.
- Plastic sandwich bag.
- Tape.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Soak bean seeds in a bowl of water overnight.
2. Dampen a paper towel with water.
3. Place the bean seeds in the middle of the damp paper towel.
4. Fold the paper towel in half, then in half again.
5. Place the wrapped bean in the plastic sandwich bag and seal it.
6. Tape the bag to a sunny window and keep the paper towel damp during the sprouting process.
7. You will have sprouted beans in just a few days!



WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Just like people, plants need food and energy! Plants make their food by using three things: water, air, and energy from the sun. Your bean seeds are waiting for the right time to start growing. Once the seeds have all three ingredients, they will germinate – which means they will begin to grow. The dry bean seeds take in as much water as they can until their outer layer sheds off, and then they can take in more air. The air helps the bean seeds grow and make energy. Then they sprout and you can start to see a little green stem!

Growing your green bookmark

Growing your own plant is so fun! You get to watch as a tiny seed blossoms into a green sprout. All you need are a few household items and a little bit of love for your bookmark seeds to grow into a plant. One of the best parts of growing your own plant is having a flowerpot to grow it in, especially a flowerpot that YOU get to paint!

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Grow your green bookmark.
- Scissors.
- A flowerpot.
- Potting soil.
- Water.
- Paint brush.
- Your favorite color paints.
- Paper plate.
- A cup of water.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FLOWERPOT

- Carefully put your favorite color of paint on a paper plate.
- Dip your paintbrush into the paint and begin painting your flowerpot.
- Remember to rinse your paintbrush in a cup of water after painting!
- Allow the painted flowerpot to dry overnight.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOOKMARK SEEDS PLANTING

- Carefully use scissors to cut along the line on the bottom of your bookmark.
- Place the seeds in a safe location.
- Begin placing potting soil inside your flowerpot until it is almost full.
- Carefully place your bookmark seeds on top of the soil.
- Make sure your seeds aren't too close together!
- Add another layer of soil.
- Water the soil until it is damp and place your pot in a sunny window or outside.
